Several years ago, Joan McLynch began hospice for complications from leukemia. Upon admission, her nurse at Care Dimensions in Danvers, MA asked about her primary goals for care and priorities for the time she had left.

"I didn't have to think about it," said Joan. "I wanted to feel good enough to make it through December to attend the New England Patriots' home game against the Miami Dolphins."

Joan's son-in-law purchased tickets for the game, and Joan's social work team asked Joan what they could do to make the day extra special.

"If you're going to go, go big," Joan said.

Once Joan's care team knew what she and her family wanted, they applied to NHF's Lighthouse of Hope Fund to pay for limousine transportation and a post-game dinner to keep the festivities going. Learning of her story, Patriots staff even issued complimentary passes for Joan and her family to be on the field for the pre-game warm up.

That Sunday, thanks to the support of her family and hospice care team, 76-year-old Joan traveled with her family by limousine to attend the game.

"It all went well and the family had a great day," said Angela O'Keefe, Care Dimensions social worker for Joan. "Even though the Patriots didn't win, the family was able to help their mom to reach one of her bucket list dreams."
